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

Multiple roots to skills and workforce shortages in our sector (and beyond)

- Demographics
- **Poor image** of the sector... and of technical education in general
- Lack of companies willing to take on apprentices (often due to small size)
- Technical schools are often outdated
- Historically male-dominated
- Particularly low productivity in our sector
- Etc...




BEWARE of the pitfalls in this debate

- "Up-skilling" is not the miracle solution
- "Re-skilling" either
- Quick quick quick! → the illusion of short trainings and extreme specialization
- ⇒ Over-emphasis on the need to improve skills. An even bigger priority is to attract new people into the sector
- ⇒ Short-term vision










